Vlogging

Vlogs – short for "video blogs" – are one of the easiest and most popular ways to reach mass audiences from the comfort of your own home. People all over the world share videos of themselves giving advice on make-up, relationships, healthy eating and all sorts of everyday topics. And some actually reach global audiences and manage to attract millions of followers because they give viewers a cozy, intimate feeling.

Vlogging became popular around 2005, when YouTube was launched.
