Convening and meeting

At least one annual in-person meeting is conducted in the context of the annual Euro-Math and Euro-Science Conference.

The other meetings are conducted online or through discord by the call of the chair or by five members after informing the chair in written form. A meeting is scheduled whenever deemed necessary.

Communication

The platform for the official communication of the committee is Discord. Emails, social media or other means may be used for communication. The official language of the platform is English.

Voting

The quorum is fulfilled with 50% of the members plus one additional member. For changes in the by-laws a quorum of 75% is required. A vote may be considered as unanimous when no objections are raised. For a yes-vote to be valid there need to be at least yes-votes of 50% percent plus 1 of the quorum participants. In case of 50% of yes-votes the chair has the decisive vote.

Appointment of members

The Members of the committee are appointed by the Thales Board of Mentors.

Positions

A Chair and a secretary are elected by the committee by simple majority at the beginning of a new fiscal year. If the chair or secretary chooses to leave a new one is elected in the next meeting by simple majority. The secretary's task is to take minutes during the meeting(s) and save them in the form of a calendar.

Fiscal year

The fiscal years begins with the school year, new members are appointed at this time.
